Continenence Foundation of Australia has a NDIS Continenence Service based in Victoria.

This is mainly a telehealth service available to Australian residents of all ages and genders.

- We also offer a home-based catheter management service local to the Surrey Hills area in Melbourne
- Continenence assessments, therapy and reviews are conducted by Nurse Continenence Specialists who are Registered Nurses with qualifications and experience in continence assessment, management, and care

What happens at a NDIS Continenence Assessment?

- Your Continenence Nurse will discuss your goals and what you would like to achieve because of your assessment
- Your Continenence Nurse will ask lots of questions about you and your bladder and/or bowel issues
- After your appointment, your Continenence Nurse will write a detailed report which will include recommendations, therapies, continence products and supports that will help you to achieve your goals
- Any suggested continence products, specific supports or therapy considered will be based on your individual situation and whether it is reasonable and necessary



Funding for your Continenence Plan

- Continenence assessments, therapy and reviews are funded under Capacity Building – Improved Daily Living
- You will require a minimum of 5-6 hours for a full assessment, detailed continence report and continence product prescription. If your needs are complex or travel is necessary, then additional hours may be required
- Your Continenence Nurse may recommend a plan for ongoing therapy and reviews to better help you achieve your goals. This will require additional hours
